## Q. 1

One of the lies of Progressive Christianity is that "we are our own god." How does living by this standard lead to hurt?

## Q.2

Relative truth is a way of saying that there is no truth. In your experience, why does God give us ultimate truth?

## Q.3

How has God's truth given you comfort even when you might not understand why it has to be that way?

## Q. 4

Why is it tempting to believe that you are good? How does accepting your sinfulness allow you to live a more fulfilling life?

## Challenge

Reflect on an area in your life where you are "your own god." What can you change this week to live by God's truth in that area?

## Key Verse

The ways of God are without fault. The Lord's words are pure. He is a shield to those who trust him.

2 Samuel 22:31

## Q. 1

What does it mean for God to be "without fault," "pure," and "a shield"?

## Q.2

God defines truth! What is an example of a truth that God gives us?

## Q.3

We are not pure like God, so God sent Jesus so that we can someday be with God in Heaven!  
Why does God want us to be with Him in Heaven?

## Q. 4

Sometimes, people tell lies and say that they are true. How can you make sure that you believe what is actually true?
