- Meet with and lead people to Jesus and mentor them along the discipleship path through scripture and our core values
- Teach volunteers and leaders to share Jesus with others
- Collaborate with the Weekend Services Team to create unique culture that actively encourages attendees to follow Jesus and invite others to the worship experience
- Pray for and with people at Wheatfield

Amazing Weekend Worship Experiences look like:

- Use skills and the skills of our volunteer teams to consistently and excellently lead worship/production in like kind and quality to other campuses
- Set up video, lights, projection, songs, and Ableton to be sent to multi-site locations
- Contribute to the creative planning and vision of what worship experiences could look like at any location

 - Coach/train current and upcoming worship leaders in private lessons
- Provide musical and production feedback for NXT GEN Student Ministry
- Set the stage for Sunday
 - o Stage builds
 - o Clean areas
 - o Band positions, piano/keys, stands, cabling, and P16s as needed
- First Church Jail Campus
 - Plan and build jail services
 - Run jail services every other Thursday morning
 - Communicate with volunteers/Recovery House
- Rehearsals
 - o Plan/Prep for rehearsals
 - Know everyone's parts
 - o Prepare ahead of time what you will work on
 - Print out music
 - Set the stage
 - Run rehearsals for morning and evening bands
- Sunday services
 - Lead Sunday worship services AM & PM
 - Lead motivational and inspiring why meetings
 - o Build relationships among the worship team in the green room
- Review and critique services
 - o Livestream sound
 - Band members musicianship and stage presence
- Work on other special projects as needed
