

Watch Party Discussion Questions:

1) What difference do you see between Christians and the world? What difference do you think you should see?

2) What does it mean to be "all in" with Jesus? How would you describe the difference between being partially committed and fully committed in your faith?

3) What areas of your life are you struggling to live in complete obedience to Jesus?

4) Living an "all out" life, chasing sin out, repenting, and following Jesus daily is so important. How do you think this level of commitment can impact your ability to be a powerful witness for Christ?

5) Have you experienced moments in your life where you felt the power of God working through you or witnessed it in others? Can you share those experiences?

6) How can we, as a group of women, support and encourage each other to be more Christlike and all in with Jesus?

7) How would your life be different if the sorts of signs that followed the early believers also followed yours?

Take Action: When we read about the early New Testament church, it's easy to assume that the power and miracles they experienced were just for them and not for us. But God is longing for us to have the same kind of impact today. I want to challenge you to start reading the book of Acts with fresh eyes, and ask the Holy Spirit to help you read it with a new perspective. Start with two to three chapters and as you read, insert your name into the stories. Remind yourself that the same Holy Spirit that dwelt in the people of the early church dwells in you.
